Experiencing live music-making can make a great impression on children and help them decide what instrument they might like to play one day. The concert will be very informal and will last for about an hour. Everyone will have a chance to join in with some singing at the end and the concert will be followed by some well-deserved refreshments, so that will be tea sorted!

GREAT OPPORTUNITY!

After the concert children from the audience will be encouraged to spend a few minutes having a go on the cello, violin and piano. Our instrumental teachers will all be on hand. The idea is for the children in the kindergarten classes to have an opportunity to find out what it's like to hold the instruments and to draw a few notes from them. Every instrument has a distinct character, as do children and it's important to give children the opportunity to have a go and see how they respond.
